

### **Information/instructions about your crowns**

#### **Temporary Crowns:**

- Made up of plastic material and cemented with temporary cement
- Work to protect the tooth while final crown is being fabricated
- May feel little more bulkier or rough and come off while chewing
- its ok to brush and floss around those as instructed
- If there are multiple temporary crowns in a row it may not be possible to floss between them
- Color may change over period of time
- If any of the above issues happen please notify us
- Please do not leave the tooth exposed or try to glue the temporary crown back with any glue from market

#### **Final Crowns:**

- As good as your natural teeth
- Brush and floss around them as your other teeth
- If the bite feels little high or not right please call us back
- Tooth or gums around it maybe sensitive for a day. If sensitivity persists or you experience any pain please notify us.

As mentioned mild discomfort can occur after the procedure be it temporary crown or final crown and should be resolved atmost with a simple pain killer whichever suits you ( not to be taken empty stomach). Please contact us if you are not sure about the dosage. If pain or discomfort continues let us know and we are here to address it for you.
