

### **Information/instructions about your Dental implants**

#### **Implant Crowns:**

- Immediately after insertion the gums around it may feel little pressured. This should resolve automatically within couple of hours. If the feeling persists or you feel gums are getting sore, please notify us.
- Continue to brush and floss around these as your natural teeth
- Avoid pulling forces like biting into caramel or sourdough bread and then pulling those off on these implant crowns
- At times the filling on top to close the screw access hole for your implant crown may come off, please let us know when that happens.
- If the bite feels high or uncomfortable please notify us
- In most cases after multiple implant crown restorations you would be prescribed an occlusal guard. Please use it diligently and notify us if there is an issue.
- On rare occasion you might feel that the implant crown is loose or wiggling slightly, please do not wait and contact us immediately.
- Lot of times we will make you temporary implant crowns during the course of treatment. These are made of plastic and hence not as strong as permanent ones. The same issues as mentioned above can happen apart from cracking and color change over a period of time. Please let us know if anything like that happens.

When you notify us of any of these issues most likely we would want you to come in as soon as possible. Remember we are here to provide you best possible care.
